— Go-ing wha - le watch-ing, wha - le watch-ing! There's still no signs of a whale!



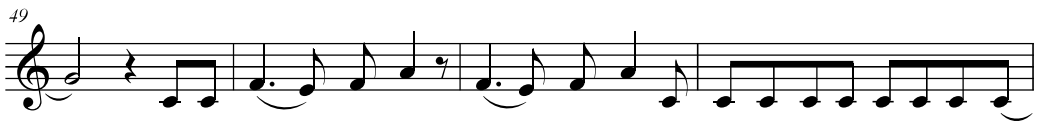
— Nope! With waves a' splash-ing, the boat is thrash-ing, I can't see a fin or a tail.
